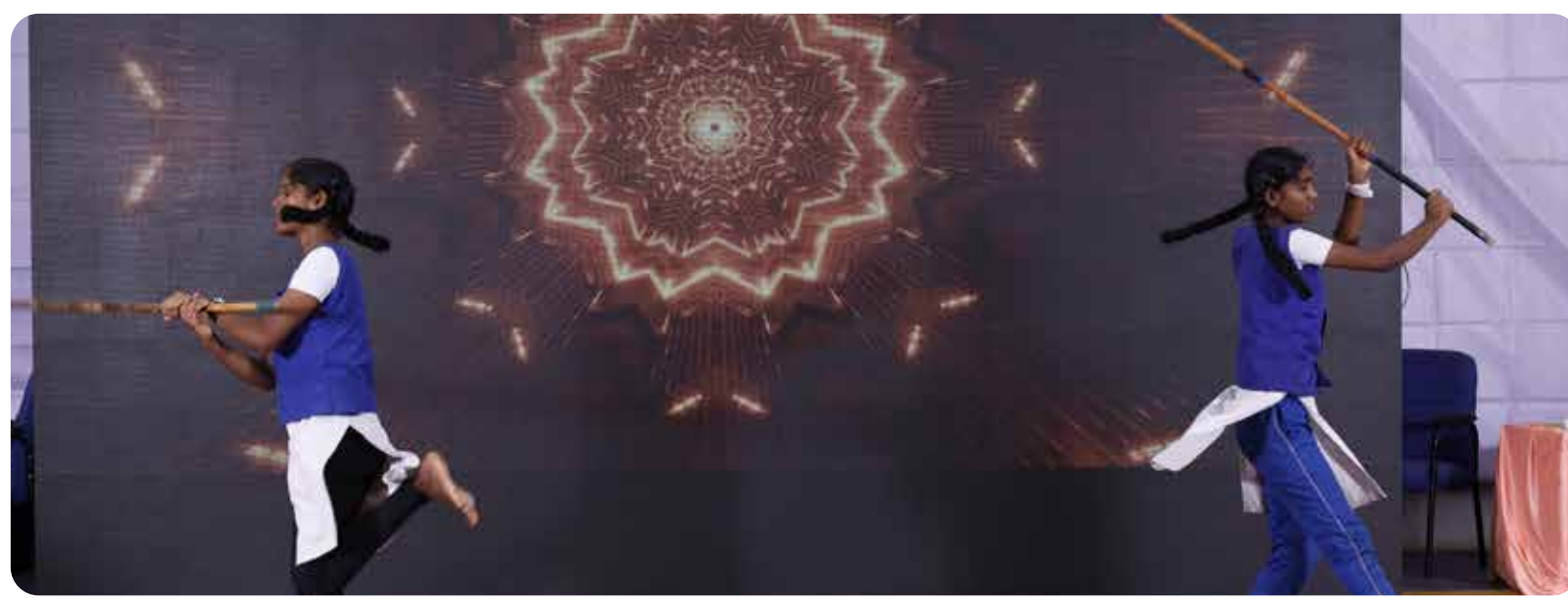

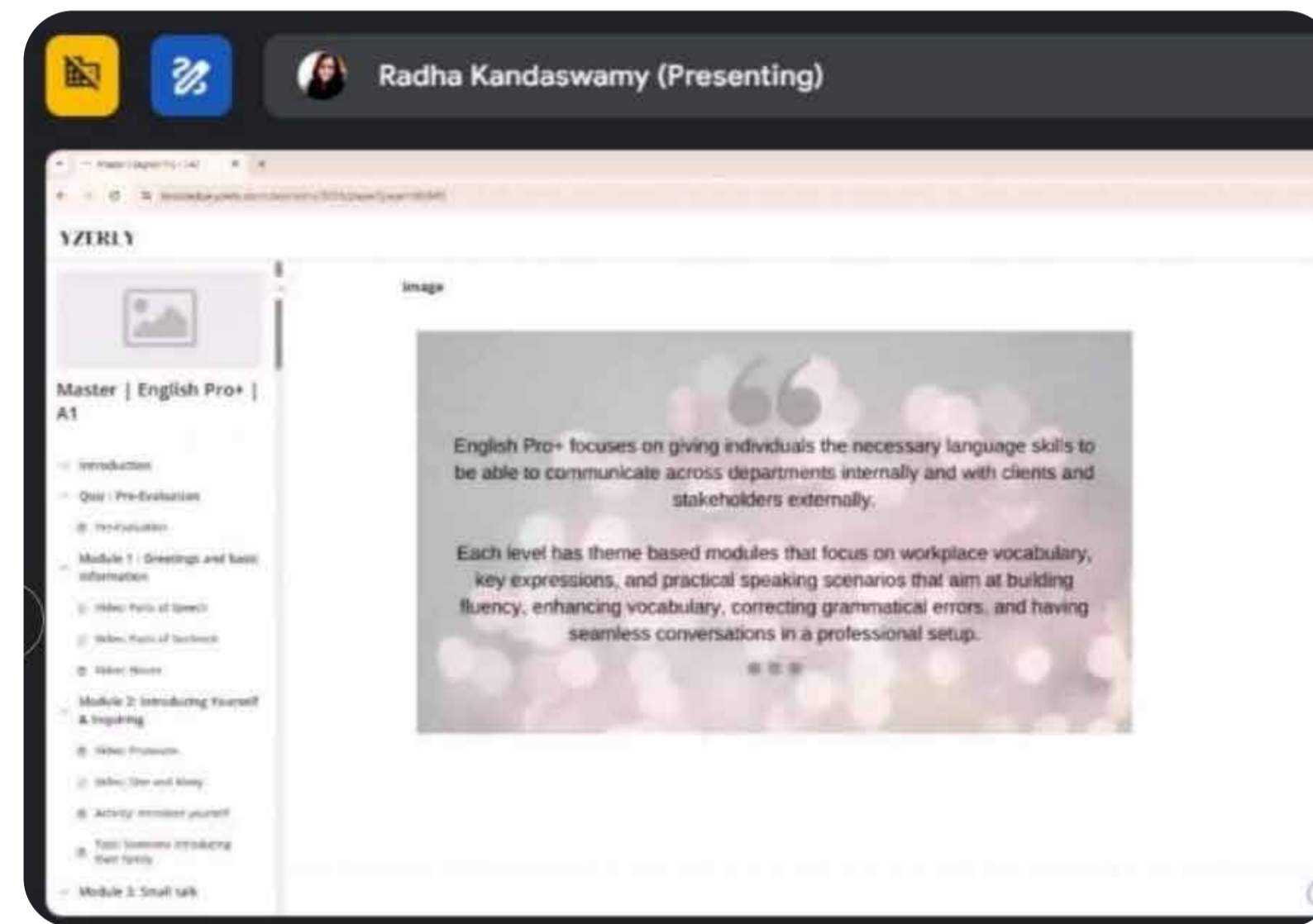
From Intent To Readiness!

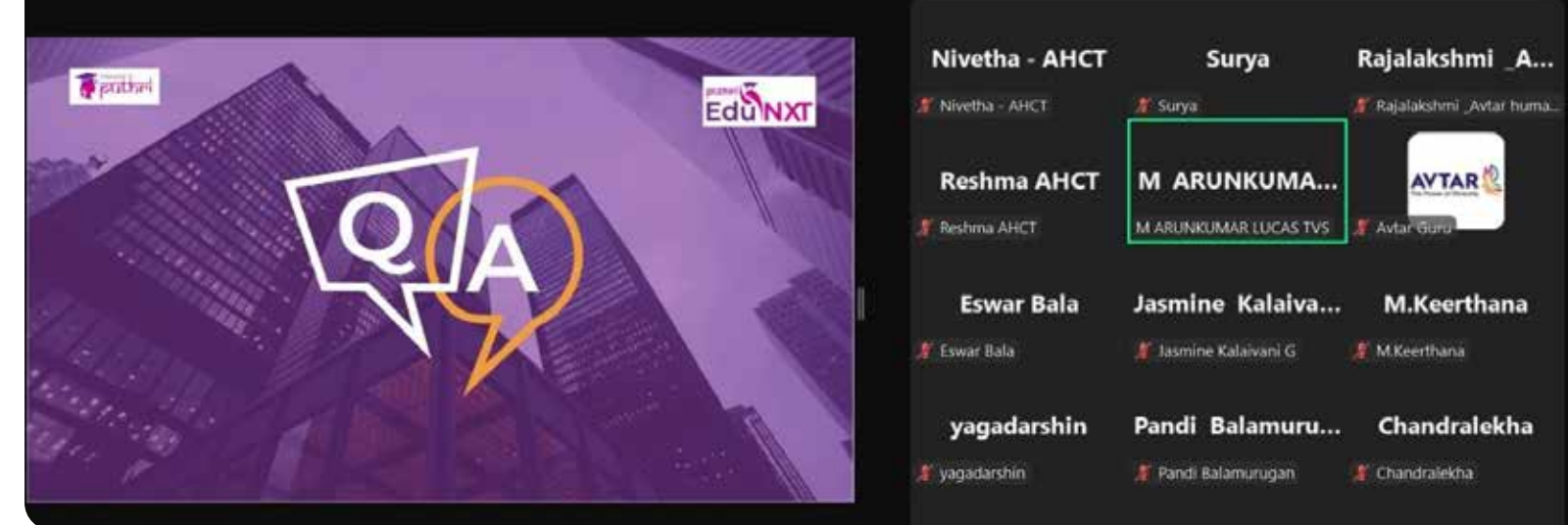

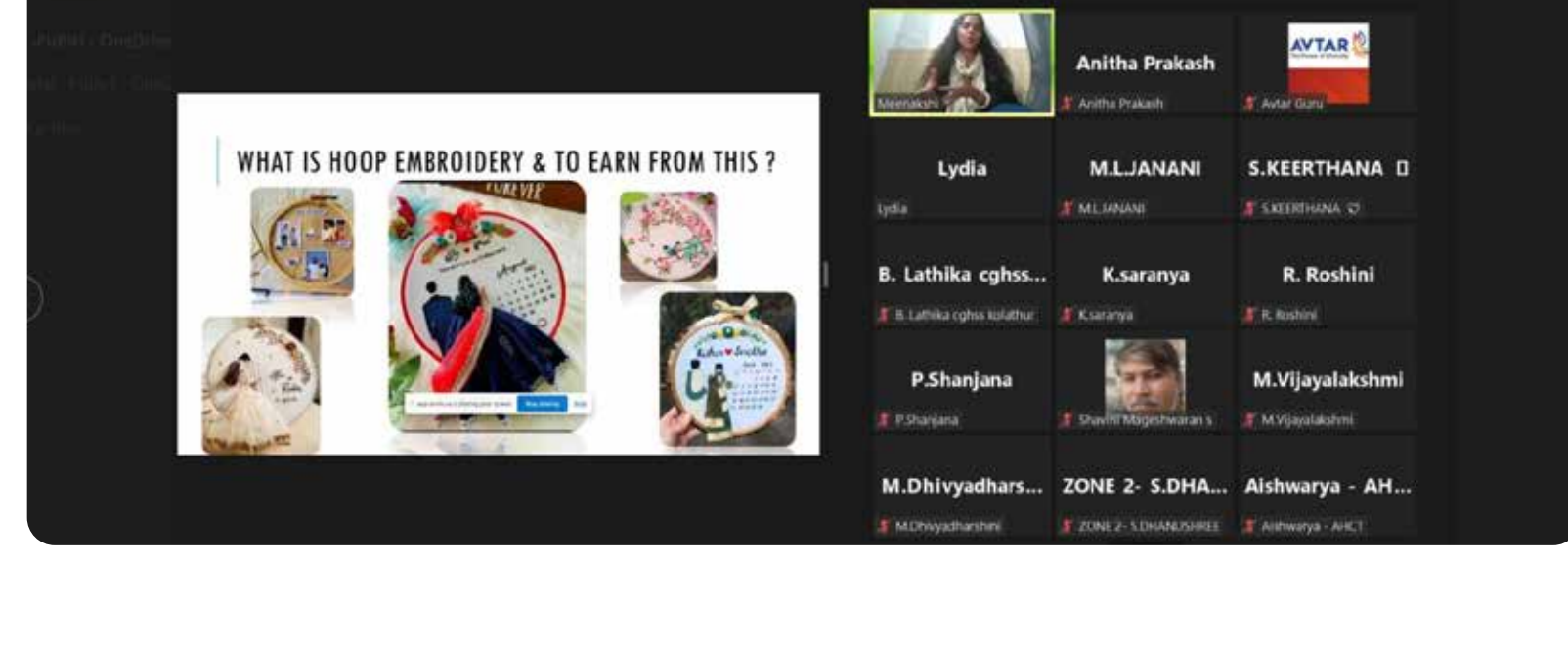

Deloitte Engagement session



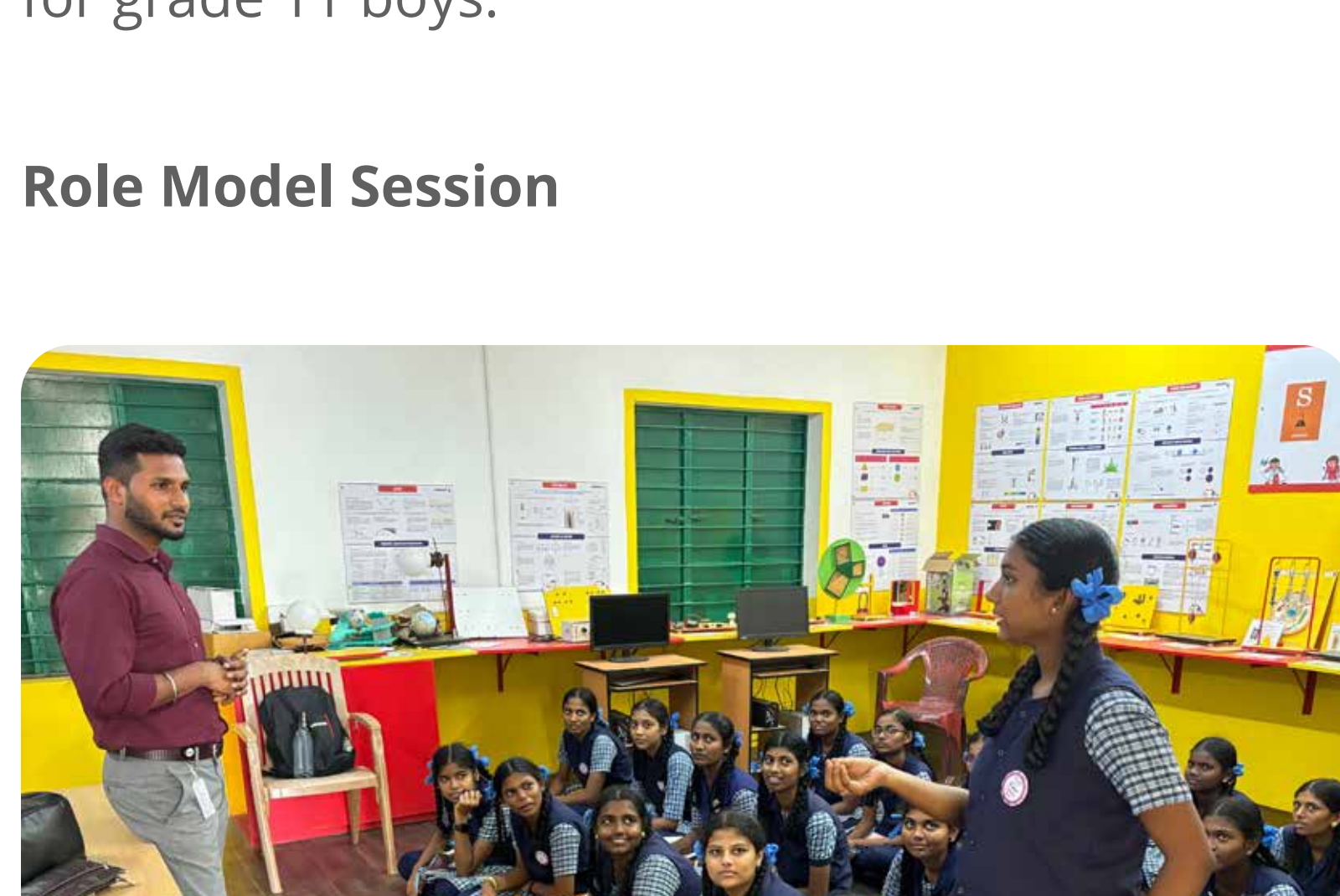

Role Model Session



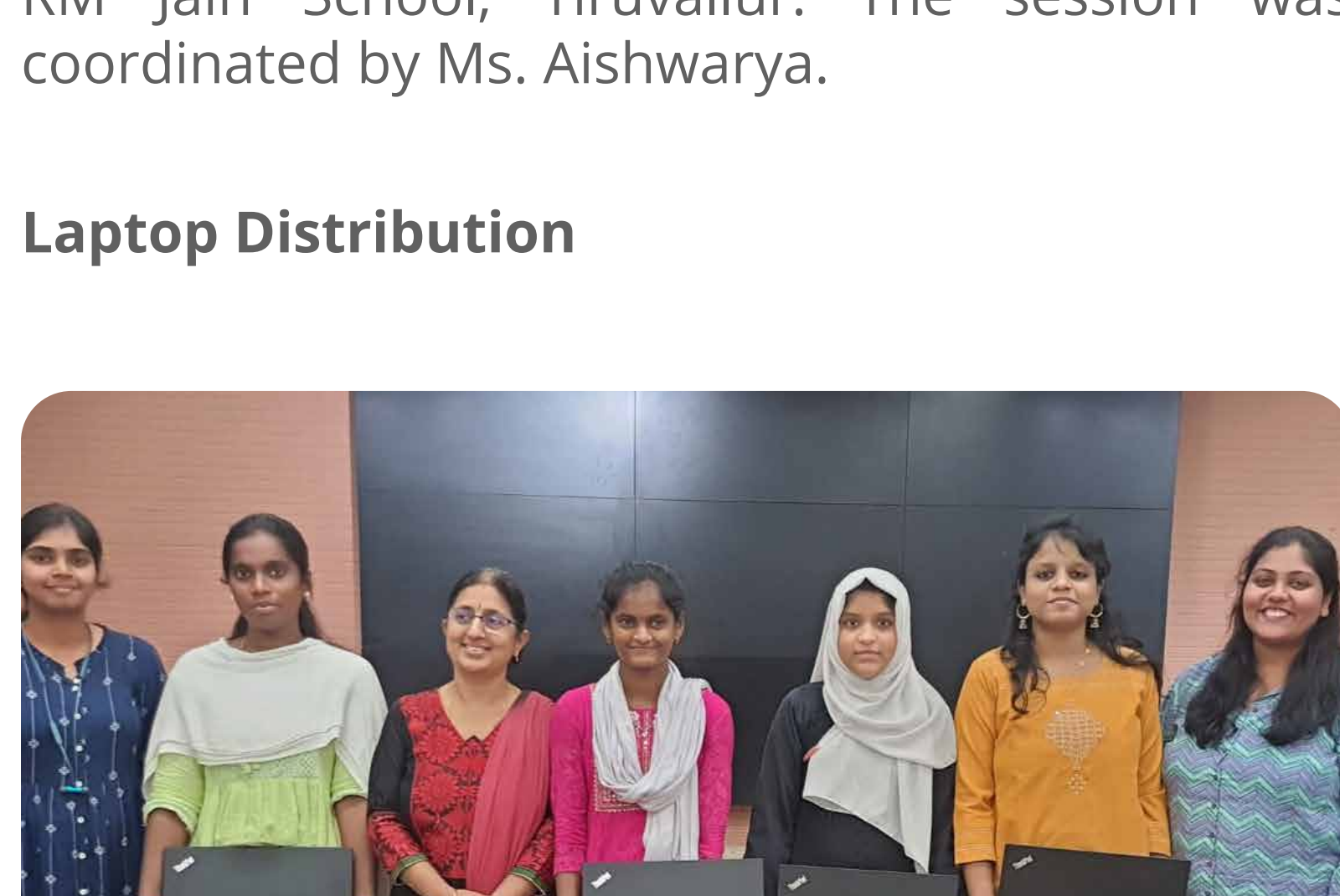

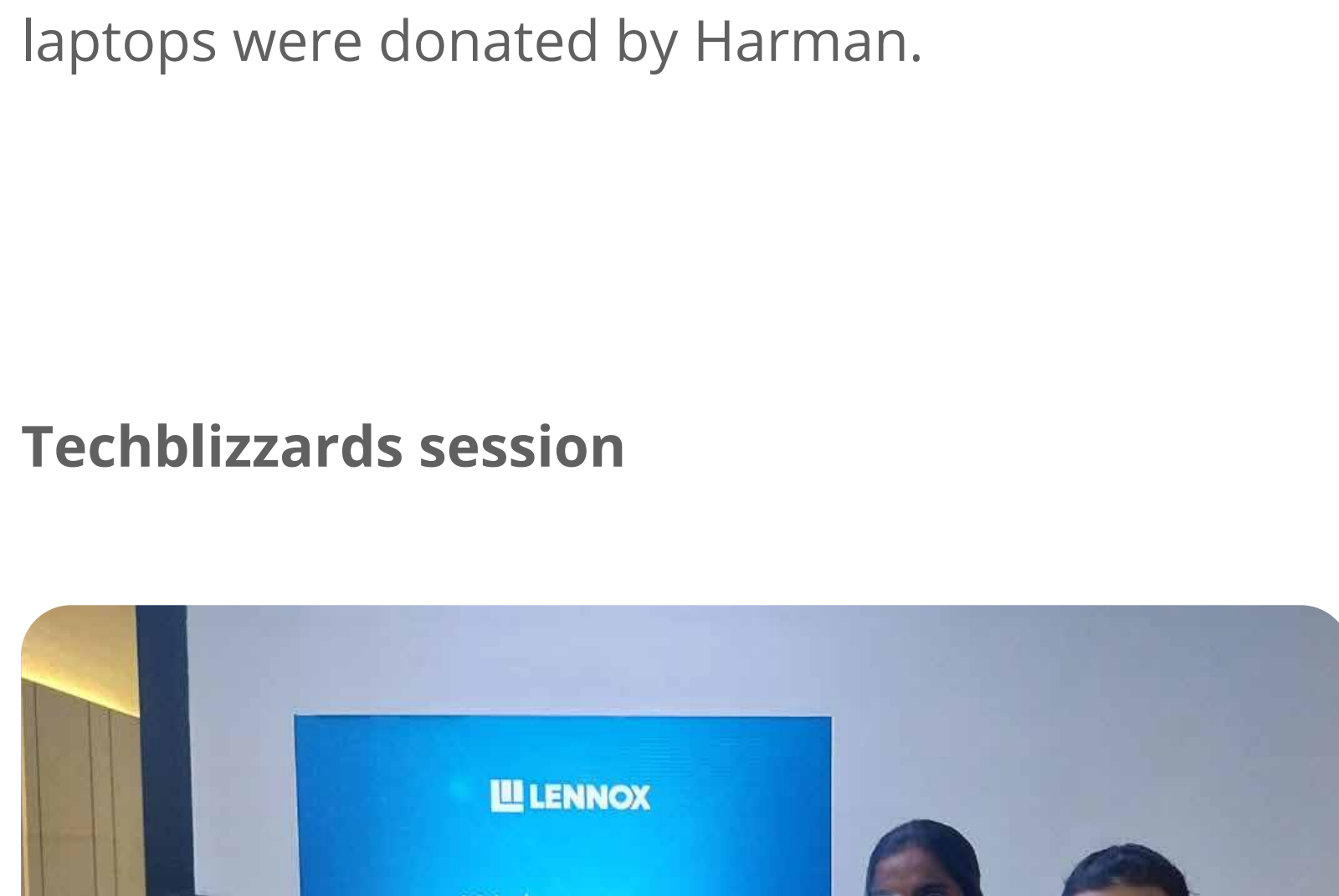
This year we supported 10 students with learning devices to continue their education. These laptops were donated by Harman.

Train The Mentor



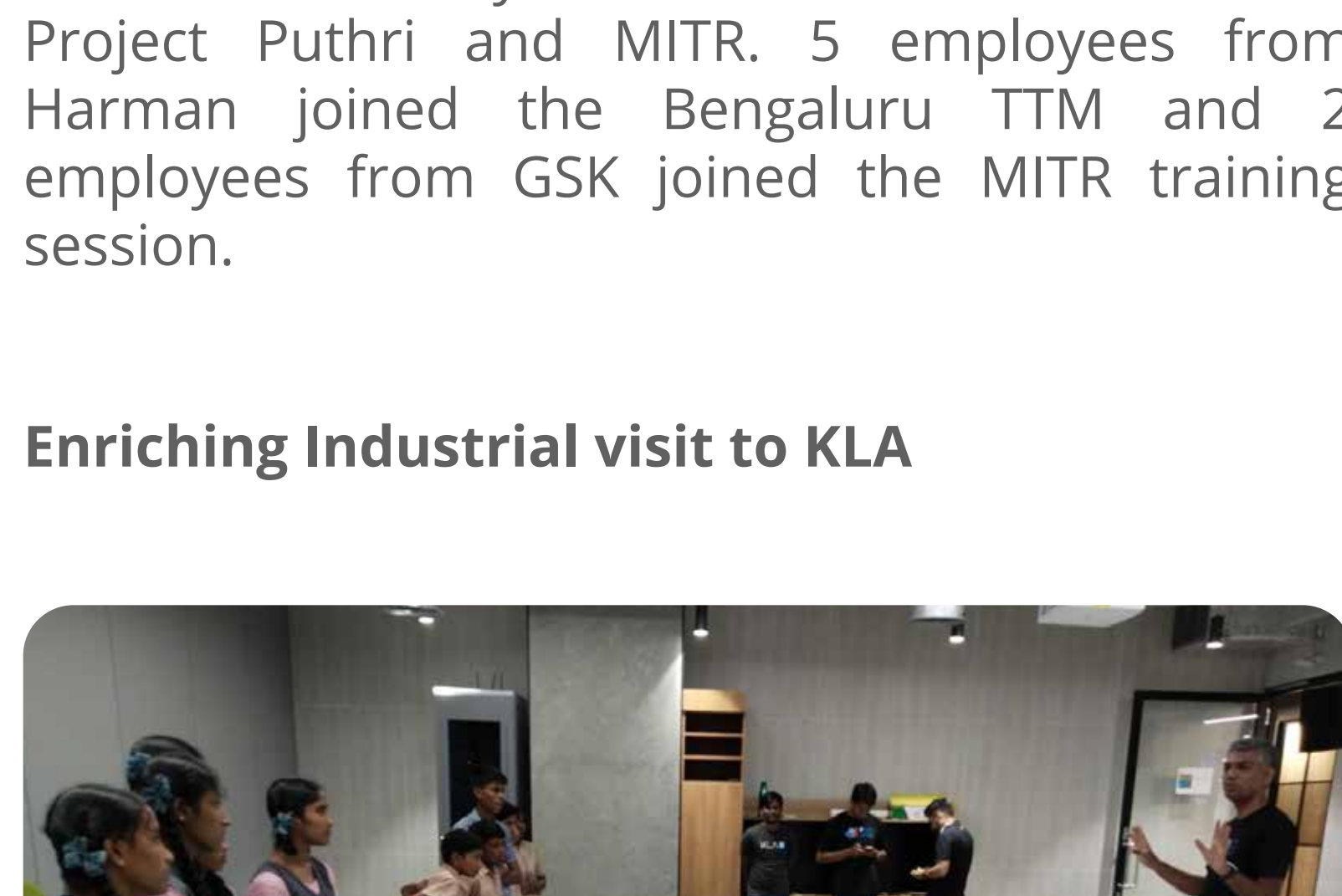

Enriching Industrial visit to KLA



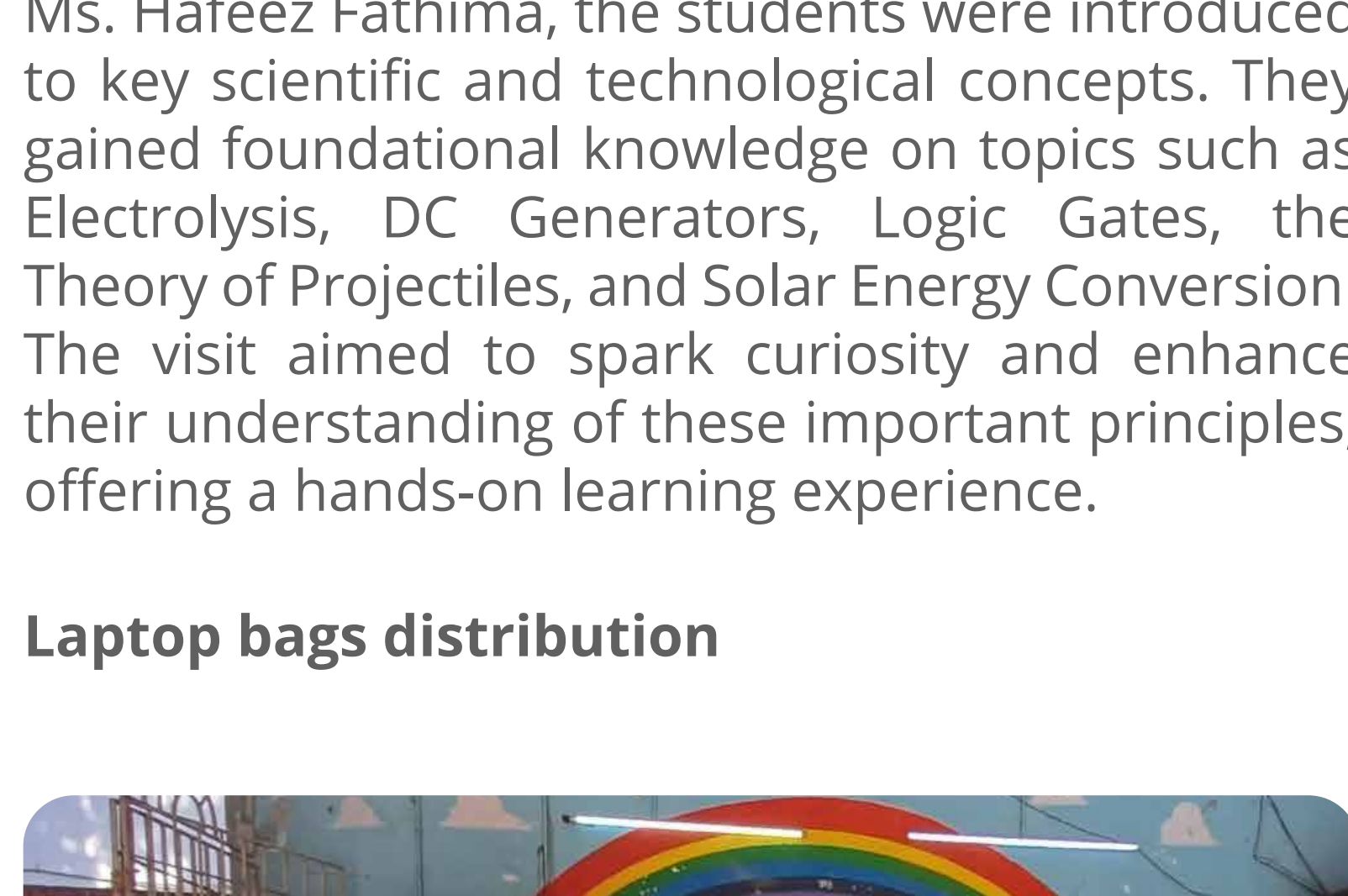
